DIRECTIONS for the impromptu speech:

There will be a paper sack filled with topics for a speech. You choose a topic. If you are willing to use that topic for your 2-minute speech, keep that topic. If that topic seems impossible for you, you may pick another topic for your speech. You must use one of the two topics for your impromptu speech. While one student prepares, one student delivers his/her speech. You will receive a planning sheet and have **7 minutes to prepare**. When you come in to speak, you **must have a 2-4 minute speech**. You'll get a signal when you make TWO MINUTES. All class members will have comment sheets to offer constructive comments about each student's speech, and you'll get a comment sheet from Mrs. Wolfe.
